
Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)

- USDE has indicated that an SEA must minimally collect from LEAs the assurances included in Section 8306 of the ESSA prior to awarding FY17 funds.
- In addition to the required LEA assurances, SEAs may collect any other information the SEA deems necessary for proper implementation of each grant program.
- The new application has been streamlined to focus on the required assurances from Section 8306 of the ESSA, as well as programmatic and fiscal information that staff have determined is necessary to properly administer each program.

LEAs are instructed to complete all sections, and are required to answer questions marked with a red asterisk. If a required question has not been completed, the business portal will highlight it in red and the section of the application will be flagged. The applicant will be unable to submit the application to NYSED for final review if a required question remains unresolved.

Transferability

- Using the “*Transfer FROM*” drop-down menu, identify the program area from which funds will be transferred .
- Please Note - transferability refers to the transferred *use* of funds, not funds actually being transferred between program area budgets.
- If applicable to your LEA, click on “Add Row” for an additional row .

- From the “*Transfer TO*” drop-down menu, select the program area to which fund use will be transferred.

Transferability Funding Information
