## What parts of New York State’s accountability system are *NOT* changing?

### Support Models and Identification Frequency

Schools and subgroups will continue to be identified for CSI or ATSI every three years while schools and subgroups will be identified for TSI or LSI annually. Districts will be identified for LSI or as Target Districts annually as well.

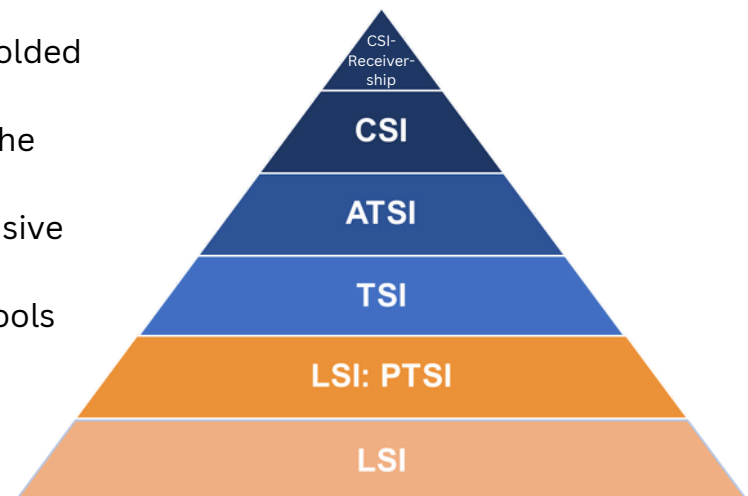

### Continuous Improvement Support

Support models are differentiated through a scaffolded continuum. Through a collaborative approach, continuous improvement is centered on meeting the needs of the local population of students.

- State- or district-supported school comprehensive education plans
- School Improvement Grant funds to Title I schools identified for qualified districts
- State-led supplemental supports



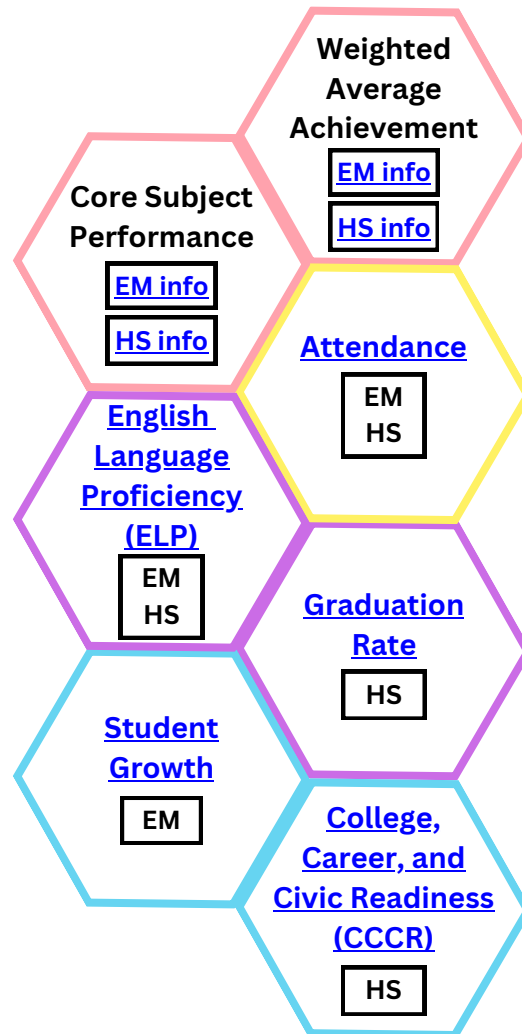
# What parts of New York State's accountability system ARE changing?

## Modified Accountability Indicators and Reintroduced Measures

While most accountability indicators will be carried over from the Rebuild Phase, some accountability indicators will be modified, restored, or replaced with a new indicator, as seen here.

EM: Elementary/Middle Level  
HS: High School Level

Click on each indicator for more information about how it will be calculated.



### Weighted Average Achievement and Core Subject Performance

- Science reintroduced for EM calculations
- Social Studies reintroduced for HS calculations (weighted equally with Science)

### Attendance

- New indicator
- Will replace Chronic Absenteeism

### ELP and Graduation Rate

- No changes from Rebuild Phase

### Student Growth and CCCR

- Restored as accountability indicators

## Modified Identification and Exit Criteria

### Identification Criteria

- Schools and subgroups will be identified using **modified decision tables**.
- Schools will be identified for TSI after meeting identification criteria for **three consecutive years**.
- Target Districts will be identified based on school-level results only.

### Exit Criteria

- Subgroups and schools will be able to exit support models if they meet exit criteria in the **second school year after initial identification** or any school year thereafter.

### Student Records Used

- The minimum n-size will be reduced **from 30 to 20** for increased subgroup representation.
- Accountability indicators will continue using **single-year data** to maintain understandability of calculations.
