The New York State Education Department requests approval for a Tydings waiver to extend the performance period and end date for liquidation of the State's FY22 Title I Part A Improving Basic Programs Operated by Local Education Agencies Program to January 28, 2026.

The extension will allow New York State Education Department to continue to obligate and draw down remaining funds from within the Improving Basic Programs Operated by Local Education Agencies Program. The pandemic led to significant delays and underspending by the grantees which the Department is working to mitigate over time through innovative and robust strategies and investments designed to address emerging needs post pandemic.
