What We Do

The NYS Statewide Language RBE-RN supports and strengthens districts and schools in their program implementation and delivery of services for MLLs/ELLs and their language programs (bilingual, world language, and heritage language) across the State of New York.

The NYS Language RBERN assists educational communities statewide to improve instructional practices and educational outcomes of MLLs/ELLs and world language students by:

- building capacity of schools and districts to implement learning standards-based instruction and assessments for MLLs/ELLs
- sharing information related to bilingual education, dual language, English as a new language, and world language programs
- serving as a clearinghouse and repository for instructional and reference materials to be used for MLLs/ELLs and world language students
- developing and disseminating content-area glossaries, resource manuals, and cultural resources in English and in the major languages spoken by MLLs/ELLs & world language students statewide
- supporting the development of statewide activities in collaboration with

institutions of higher education, community-based organizations, regional RBERNs, professional organizations, and NYSED OBE-WL

- collaborating with New York State Education Department networks in providing technical assistance to close the achievement gap for low performing districts and schools
- collaborating with the other Regional RBE-RNs to assist New York State schools to develop state and federal grants, secure translation services, and promote awareness of the native languages and cultures of NYS MLLs/ELLs and world language students
- working with parent groups and community-based organizations to promote parent engagement and support learning initiatives in educating MLLs/ELLs
- maintaining NYS ELL/MLL Hotline responding to inquiries from parents and others regarding rights and services for ELLs/MLLs
- coaching school leaders on the effective planning and implementation of programs for ELLs and world language students
