Data Privacy and Security Quick Reference For Superintendents¹

Laws you must know:

- Family Educational Rights Privacy Act (FERPA)
- Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)
- New York Education Law § 2-d and Part 121 of the regulations of the Commissioner of Education

What's required under Ed Law § 2-d and Part 121:

- Districts *must* enter into a data protection agreement (DPA) when sharing student data with third party contractors (includes studies and research and audits (not OSC audits)).
- Districts must share supplemental information about their data sharing (contracts) and it must be on their website.
- Districts *must* designate a Data Protection Officer (DPO).
- Districts *must* adopt a Parents Bill of Rights and it must be on their website.
- b Districts *must* annually train their staff in data privacy and awareness.
- Districts *must* report data breaches and unauthorized disclosures and releases to the NYSED Privacy Office.
- B Student data cannot be sold or used for commercial or marketing purposes.

Policies your district cannot live without:

- FERPA Annual Notification to Parents
- Incident response plan
- Parents Bill of Rights
- Data security and privacy policy
 - Adopts NIST CSF ideally Version 2

Filing a data incident report:

- Erroneous or accidental accessibility or disclosure report form
- Data Incident Reporting form for unauthorized accessibility or disclosure of protected data (A/K/A the "Breach Form")
- Instructions for completing the Erroneous or accidental accessibility disclosure report form

What to do when a parent files a privacy complaint:

 Assist either the New York State Education Department's Privacy Office or the U.S.D.O.E.'s Privacy Technical Assistance Center (PTAC) with their investigation.
