- Administers and monitors State Funded Universal Prekindergarten programs




THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION AND REPORTING SERVICES (IRS)

IRS is responsible for State and Federal reporting requirements of data reported to NYSED from schools (including public, charter, religious, and independent schools) and public-school districts in New York State:

- oversees and directs the reporting of data from all required educational reporting entities to the Student Information Repository System (SIRS);
- ensures accurate and timely reporting for students, educators, and institutions;
- collaborates with all program offices, including OEL, to meet their data needs.



How Data Gets to NYSED






How NYSED Uses Data







Where are Child Counts Reported?






UPK and SUFDPK CODING IN SIRS 2024-2025
