A. Organization

- Task 2 is organized according to the "Blue Memo"
 - Task 2.2 addresses teachers who receive a State-provided growth measure: grades 4-8 ELA and Math.
 - Tasks 2.3 through 2.5 address teachers whose courses end with a State or Regents assessment and who use SLOs:
 - Task 2.3: 3 ELA and math
 - Task 2.4: 4 and 8 science
 - Task 2.5: high school courses that that end in a Regents exam
 - Task 2.6 addresses high school ELA teachers, for which the ELA
 Regents must be given in at least one grade level and who use SLOs.
 - Tasks 2.7 through 2.9 address teachers of courses that do not end with a State or Regents assessment and who use SLOs:
 - Task 2.7: K-2 ELA and math
 - Task 2.8: 6 and 7 science and grades 6-8 social studies
 - Task 2.9: Global Studies I
 - Task 2.10 addressed teachers of "All Other Courses."

- Be sure to always read, understand, and check all assurances.



Assure that back-up SLOs will be set by the superintendent or another trained administrator for all 4-8 ELA and Math teachers in the event that a State-provided growth score cannot be generated for that teacher.

For any grade/subject that requires a back-up SLO, but for which there are not enough students, not enough scores, or data issues that prevent a teacher-specific SLO from being created, the superintendent or another trained administrator shall develop a school-wide back-

- An example of entering a back-up SLO for grade 4 ELA and math is below.



- Grade 3 ELA and math, grade 4 and 8 science, high school math, science, and social studies
- End in a State or Regents assessment, but use SLOs






D. SLOs: Courses Ending with a State or Regents Assessment




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Measures




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F. SLOs: High School ELA

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G. SLOs: Courses without a State or Regents Assessment

Tasks 2.7 through 2.10

- K-2 ELA and math, 6-7 science, and 6-8 social studies, Global I, All Other Courses
- These are courses that do not receive a State-provided growth score, and the following options, as illustrated in slides 15-17, may be used as evidence within the SLO:
 - 1. State-approved third party assessment (or "non-traditional standardized" for K-2)
 - 2. State-approved district, regional, or BOCES-developed assessment
 - 3. School-, or BOCES-wide group, team or linked results based on State/Regents assessments



G. SLOs: Courses without a State or Regents Assessment

All Other Courses

- Indicate the following using the dropdown menus:
 - Column 1: lowest grade that corresponds to the course
 - Column 2: highest grade that corresponds to the course
 - Column 3: subject of the course
 - Column 4: measure used



- Once a measure is selected, a corresponding menu will appear for the selection of the name(s) of the assessment(s) used.
- To add an additional course, check the box as shown.





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H. Assigning a 0-20 Score and HEDI Rating

 Task 2.11 contains the State-determined HEDI scoring bands that must be used when assigning 0-20 scores and HEDI ratings to teachers.

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I. Weighting

- If the Optional subcomponent (addressed in Task 3) is not used, the Required subcomponent will be weighted 100% of the Student Performance category.
- If the Optional subcomponent is used, the Required subcomponent must comprise at least 50% of the Student Performance category.
 - The use of the Optional subcomponent and corresponding weighting, as applicable, is entered into Task 2.14, shown below.

Please indicate the use of the Optional subcomponent by making the appropriate selection below. Information related to the Optional subcomponent will be entered into Task 3.

- The Optional subcomponent WILL NOT be used; the Required subcomponent will comprise 100% of the Student Performance category.
- The Optional subcomponent WILL be used; the weight of each subcomponent is indicated below.

Select the weight of the Required Student Performance subcomponent; the corresponding Optional Student Performance subcomponent weight is shown.
