# Educator Evaluation Data Reporting

# Data Elements Required for Reporting under Education Law §3012-e

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The following data elements will be required for reporting evaluation ratings under Education Law §3012-e:

## Final Standard Ratings

- For each evaluated NYS Teaching Standard/Professional Standard for Educational Leaders based on the measures included in the current Standards-based Educator Evaluation and Professional Support System (STEPS) plan.

## Overall Rating

- Based on the evaluated standards, per the process included in the current STEPS plan.

# Educator Evaluation Reporting under Education Law §3012-e: Logistics

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- The data submission deadline is in October; however, since State-provided growth scores are no longer required for educator evaluation, LEAs are encouraged to submit as early as possible.
  - The data collection period begins in July; August is suggested as the target for submission.
- Only one set of ratings should be submitted for each educator, and the submitted elements should be consistent with the evaluation cycle included in the current STEPS plan.

- An Educator Evaluation summary from the Office of Educator Quality and Professional Development is available for each LEA through [SED Monitoring](#) in the Educator Quality portal. This document summarizes the elements necessary for rating distribution and data submission reflective of the corresponding evaluation plan and is updated as a new plan is accepted by the Department.

# Reporting Ratings for plans under Education Law §3012-e

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- All evaluations will be based on the measures included in the current STEPS plan.
- *Probationary educators* must be rated on all standards and receive an overall rating annually.
- *Tenured educators* must be rated on all standards across an annual or multi-year evaluation cycle and receive an overall rating at the conclusion of this cycle.

- Final standard ratings, as applicable, will be reported as a value of 1, 2, 3, or 4, for each evaluated NYS Teaching Standard using the applicable code.
