As outlined in the August 21, 2024, 2024-2025 Performance Management, Technical Assistance, and Reporting (Guidance Memo), the period for activities to be included in the Quarter 3 Report is from *February 1, 2025, to April 30, 2025.* The deadline for submitting the Quarter 3 Report is **April 30, 2025.**
