The Office of Bilingual Education and World Languages (OBEWL) of the New York State Education Department (NYSED) presents this next webinar in its 2025 Professional Learning Series: **Presentational and Interpersonal Communication for Classical Languages - Part 1**. This webinar is offered free of charge for world language educators and administrators working and studying in New York State educational institutions. 1 hour of CTLE credit offered.



Webinar description: Building on the previous Classical Languages webinar on Standard 1, Interpretive Communication, we will dive into the two output standards: Standard 2 - Presentational Communication; and Standard 3 - Interpersonal Communication. Participants will explore ways to create engaging contexts for students to share their proficiency in the target language in Presentational Writing and Speaking, as well as Interpersonal Speaking. We will consider a variety of Presentational and Interpersonal Strategies integrated in the context of thematic lessons.

Registration process: All participants must pre-register for this event. Pre-registration will close on Friday, March 21, 2025; there will be no same-day registrations. Once the registrant's email address has been verified as being from a New York State school, college, or university, an email confirming their registration will be sent. Twenty-four hours prior to the event, all registered individuals will receive login instructions with the link to join the webinar. **Only pre-registered attendees will be eligible for a certificate documenting attendance and/or CTLE hours.**
